Once your email has been sent, HCFVC will contact you via email with a fillable form to complete this process. To donate using via credit card please click "Donate Via Credit Card".

Each brick will be allowed up to 3 lines and up to 20 characters per line, including spaces and punctuation. All submissions are subject to County of Ventura approval.

A Heartfelt Grateful Patient Story from VCMC's NICU

When Martin and Janelle Hahn's son, Cooper, was admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Ventura County Medical Center (VCMC), their world was turned completely upside down. Cooper was diagnosed with a severe case of laryngomalacia, a condition caused by a congenital abnormality in the voice box that can affect breathing. Despite several medical interventions and a surgical procedure, his recovery was slower than expected, raising serious concerns. Cooper was placed on the transfer list for



Children's Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA), an upsetting prospect for any parent.

Advised to be ready to leave at a moment's notice, the Hahn family packed their bags for what would be an unknown length of stay at CHLA.

That's when Dr. Sumiyoshi and the NICU medical team decided to transport an Olympus Rhino-Laryngoscope from a VCHCA outpatient clinic to the NICU to take a closer look at Cooper's condition. This advanced imaging equipment allowed the medical team to identify and confirm that Cooper was on the right path toward recovery; affording the Hahn family the ability to remain at home with their local support network and continue their care with the NICU team at VCMC with whom they had established trust and rapport.

Martin and Janelle Hahn remain grateful for the exceptional care provided by Dr. Sumiyoshi, Dr. Krebs, and the entire NICU team. Their compassion and expertise were instrumental in guiding Cooper's recovery.

Health Care Foundation for Ventura County is pleased to announce that, thanks to grant funding, we will acquire a dedicated Olympus Rhino-Laryngoscope for VCMC. This addition will ensure more families receive the same outstanding care Cooper did, right here in Ventura County. HCFVC is deeply grateful to the Hahn family for generously sharing their uplifting story.

retirement. With many options available, including bequests, charitable gift annuities,


and 401(k) designations, this tool is safe, secure, and does not require sensitive security information.


